JOB DESCRIPTION: NATIONAL SECURITY

Position: Chairman (appointed position)

Purpose: National Security program maintains and promotes a strong national defense by strengthening and supporting military service members and their families. Support active-duty military families by working with an installation Family Readiness Group (FRG).

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Attend General Membership meetings.
2. Assist in giving information on the Department of National Security programs.
3. Host 2 blood drives a year for the American Red Cross – April & October
4. Troop Shipping comes under the National Security umbrella.
5. Raise awareness of POW/MIA and the work being performed by the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency (DPAA) in the search for missing personnel.
6. The ALA National Security program maintains and promotes a strong national defense by strengthening and supporting military service members and their families.
7. Support all military families by working with their command group and family readiness groups.
8. Support and enhance Legion Family and partner initiatives that strive to improve our servicemembers' Quality of Life (QoL) and their families.
